

The municipality applies recycle tariffs to encourage waste separation. This means less residual waste and better separation of raw materials such as vegetable, fruit and garden waste (VGF) and food waste, plastic, cans and drinking cartons, textiles and paper. Good separation will keep waste charges as low as possible.

What does the recycling tariff look like?

You can influence the amount of the waste disposal charges. The waste disposal charges consist of a fixed and a variable part. The amount of the variable part is determined by the number of times you dispose of your residual waste or use the underground container for residual waste. With the recycle tariff, you can therefore influence the amount of your waste disposal charges.

Smart HVC app that helps you separate waste

You can download HVC's app. The app keeps track of how often your mini-container for residual waste has been emptied or how often you have used the underground container for residual waste. This is handy because it lets you see at a glance whether you are on track with your waste separation resolution for this year. The app lets you set your own target and challenges you to achieve it. And you can see at a glance when your waste will be collected.

You can also see in the app how often you offered residual waste in the previous year. To do this, you must have an HVC account. Open the app and open the 'for you' tab. Click on the block where you can set a target. Here you will find the history. Please note, the app only displays the times from when you created an account. Do you not see the history for the period when you already had an account? If so, you may need to update the app.

The app is available for Apple and Android users and can be downloaded for free from the AppStore or GooglePlay.
